## **Section I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB)**

*ITB shall be read in conjunction with section II, Bidding Data Sheet (BDS), which shall take precedence over ITB.*

### **01. INTRODUCTION**

- 01.1 The **National Livestock Development Board (NLDB)**, established in **1973**, is the **largest government-owned livestock organization in Sri Lanka**. It currently operates **33 livestock farms** across the country, catering to various livestock species for **breeding purposes**. These farms primarily maintain **large-scale European dairy cattle breeds** to meet the national demand for **high-quality breeding material** among local farmers.
- 01.2 Procurement is conducted primarily through **Limited International Competitive Bidding (LIB)**, in full compliance with the **terms, conditions, and specifications** set forth in this document.
- 01.3 **Foreign suppliers** or their **accredited agents/representatives** for the Sri Lankan market are **eligible to submit bids**. If a bidder is participating as an **agent**, they must provide **valid documentary evidence** confirming their authority to act on behalf of the **principal supplier**.

### **02. SUBMISSION OF BID**

- 02.1. Bids must be submitted in **one original** and **one duplicate**, each **sealed separately** and clearly marked as **“Original”** and **“Duplicate”**, respectively. Both envelopes shall be enclosed in a **single outer envelope**, sealed and marked **“Importation of 5,000 Doses of Sex-Sorted Bovine Semen”**, and addressed to:

- 02.2. Sealed bids may be submitted either by **registered post** or **deposited in the Tender Box** at the above address. All bids must be **received on or before 10:30 hrs. (UTC+5:30) on 08/09/2025**.
- 02.3. Fax or E-mail offers sent directly to NLDB are not acceptable.
- 02.4. The **top left-hand corner** of the outer envelope must clearly indicate the **Bid Reference Number** (**NLDB/06/01/S.S/2025**) and the **closing date and time** of the bid.
- 02.5. Late submissions will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- 02.6. Bids must follow the format provided in **Section IV (Annex A & B)**.

02.7. All items offered must comply with the technical specifications in **Section VI**.

02.8. Non – Confirming or non-responsive bids will be rejected.

### **3. FORMAT OF BID**

03.1. Bids must follow the format given in **Section IV (Anex A & B)**

03.2. At Bid opening, only the item number and price will be read out. So, price must be shown against each item number.

03.3. Bids not in the prescribed format or not conforming to the terms, conditions and specifications including veterinary Health requirements, will be rejected.

03.4. Bids shall contain no interlineations, or overwriting, except for corrections initialed by the person (s) signing the bid.

03.5. All Bids and supporting must be in the **English**.

03.6. NLDB reserves the right to reject any non-confirming or non-responsive bid at any time.

03.7. Bids must be signed by the bidder or authorized personnel (with name and designation) or a representative with a letter of authorization

### **4. VALIDITY OF OFFER**

04.1. Validity Period of the Bid - 119 **days**

### **5. BID OPENING**

05.1. Bids will be opened immediately after closing at **10:30 hrs. (UTC+5:30) on 08/09/2025** at the NLDB Head office No.40, Nawala Road, Narahenpita, Colombo - 05, Sri Lanka

05.2. Bidders or their authorized representatives may attend the bid opening.

05.3. Only the '**Original**' copy of the bid will be opened.

05.4. The Bid Opening Committee will read out the bidder's name, quoted amount, and any discounts.

05.5. Additional details deemed necessary by the committee may also be read out

## 6. FORCE MAJEURE

- 06.1. If a supplier cannot complete the contract on time due to unavoidable events (E.g., war, natural disasters, epidemics, or freight issues), the delay may be excused. The supplier must notify NLDB in writing within 7 days of the event, providing evidence (e.g., official reports, certifications).
- 06.2. The Chairman of the Procurement Committee may extend the delivery time or cancel the award based on the evidence provided.

## 7. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

- 07.1. No Contract may be assigned or sublet without NLDB's authority. NLDB refuse to recognize a Power of Attorney issued by the contractor to another party.

## 8. FREE REPLACEMENT / REIMBURSEMENT

- 08.1. NLDB may demand free replacement or reimbursement for short-packed, lost, damaged or deteriorated goods within the shelf-life, or for packs with unidentifiable or incorrect labeling.
- 08.2. In case of withdrawals due to quality failure, suppliers must reimburse the entire quantity of the withdrawn batches or products, plus additional 25% of the total value as an administrative cost.

## 9. DELIVERY

- 09.1. **Shipping Term** - CIP Colombo basis as per Incoterms 2020. FOB offers are not accepted.

## 10. PACKING AND STORAGE / CONDITIONS

- 10.1. **Packing & Storage:**

Semen must be packed in **liquid nitrogen (LN<sub>2</sub>) compliant straws, maintained at -196°C**, and stored in **cryo-canisters** suitable for international transport. Suppliers must provide returnable liquid nitrogen tanks, with return shipping costs borne by the supplier. Tanks must be returned within 30 days of delivery.

- 10.2. **Visual Labels:**

Each container/goblet must clearly indicate the **Breed, Batch number, Bull ID, Collection Code, Name of the Bull, Stud Code, Collection Date & Manufacturing Date**

10.3. **Other Documents & Semen Flask**

The Above details and HS Code (0511.10) must also be included in all **supply invoices, Packing List & Semen Flask**

10.4. **Supplier Responsibility:**

Suppliers are responsible for ensuring all semen containers remain intact and undamaged until delivery to NLDB.

10.5. **Liability for Damages:**

Any damage due to non-compliance with packing and storage conditions is the supplier's responsibility, with full costs borne by the supplier.

**11. BID PRICE & CURRENCY**

11.1. **Bid Price** - CIP Colombo basis as per Incoterms 2020. FOB offers are not accepted.

12.2. **Currency** - USD (\$) or Euro (€)

**12. COUNTRY OF ORIGIN, PORT OF SHIPMENT, AND SUPPLIER DETAILS**

12.1. The Country of Origin, Port of Shipment, HS Code (0511.10), and supplier details must be included in the quotation

**13. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS & CERTIFICATES**

13.1. Bidders must submit all veterinary health requirements and related documents as **specified by the Department of Animal Production & Health (DAPH), Sri Lanka, (Section III)** including;

- Certificates confirming bulls are free from Brucellosis, Tuberculosis, Johne's Disease, Bovine Leukocyte Adhesion Disease (BLAD), Deficiency of Uridine Mono-Phosphate Synthetase (DUMPS), Citrullinemia, and Factor XI Deficiency.
- Compliance with OIE Terrestrial Manual standards for bovine semen trade.
- Certificates issued by a competent veterinary authority in the country of origin.

#### 14. PAYMENT & BANK CHARGERS

- 14.1. Payment Term - **Irrevocable letter of Credit at sight LC**
- 14.2. Suppliers must provide accurate **beneficiary bank details** in their original offer. Costs for LC amendments or cancellations due to supplier errors or changes in beneficiary details will be borne by the supplier. Amendments requested by NLDB will be at NLDB's expense.
- 14.3. All Bank Charges incurred outside Sri Lanka are to the beneficiary's account.
- 14.4. Delivery must be made within the LC's validity, with extensions granted only in exceptional circumstances at the beneficiary's cost.
- 14.5. The LC will be advised through the correspondent Bank of NLDB's bankers in the successful bidder's country. Unless otherwise specified in the bid.

#### 16. CONTRACT

- 16.1. The successful supplier should agree to enter into a Contract / Agreement (**Section VII**) within 07 days of receiving the letter of award.

#### 17. LOCAL AGENT

- 17.1. The supplier must indicate the name, address, and contact details of their agent in Sri Lanka in the bid.

#### 18. EXAMINATION, EVALUATION, AND COMPARISON OF OFFERS

- 18.1. **Purpose:** To determine the lowest evaluated bid from the substantially responsive bids.
- 18.2. **Preliminary examination:** The Bid Evaluation Committee will check;
- Bidder's **eligibility**
  - Proper **signing** and **authorization** of the bid.
  - Submission of **only one offer**.
  - Absence of **computational or arithmetic errors**
  - Compliance with the **Bid Submission Form (Section IV Annex - A)** and **Price Schedule (Section IV Annex - B)**.

**18.3. Prior to Detailed Evaluation:**

- The Bid Evaluation Committee will ensure substantial responsiveness to all conditions without any deviations.
- Arithmetical errors will be corrected as follows;
  - Unit Price prevails over Total Price.
  - Amounts in words prevail over figures.
  - Original copy prevails over duplicate.
- All items must conform to technical specifications.

**18.4. Evaluation Criteria:** Bids will be evaluated based on;

- Price (50%)
- Past Performance (20%)
- Quality of Documentation (20%)
- Delivery Schedule (10%)

The lowest-priced, substantially responsive bid meeting all technical specifications will be prioritized.

**19. BID AWARD**

- 19.1. The successful bidder will be notified via email, followed by a formal Letter of Award.
- 19.2. Awards are based on quoted prices, past performances, quality of documentation, delivery schedule, and product registration status.
- 19.3. NLDB reserves the right to,
- Accept any bid, in whole or in part.
  - Accept portions of multiple bids.
  - Reject any or all bids.
  - Call for fresh bids.
  - Cancel the bidding process at any stage.
- 19.4. NLDB may cancel or suspend the procurement if the supplier is listed as a defaulted supplier due to prior quality failures or non-compliance.

## **20. COPY DOCUMENTS**

- 20.1. The **successful bidder** must send a complete set of supporting documents to NLDB via email or courier at least 7 days prior to the consignment's arrival in Sri Lanka to avoid customs clearance delays. Documents include;
- Copy of Air Waybill (AWB).
    - Veterinary Health Certificates.
    - Insurance Certificate.
    - Certificate of Country of Origin.
    - Packing List (with gross/net weights, package dimensions, contents, manufacture/expiry dates).
    - Commercial Invoice (showing CIP value breakdown, FOB, freight, HS Code 0511.10).
- 20.2. Demurrage or additional charges due to non-compliance will be borne by the supplier.

## **21. ALTERNATIVE BIDS**

- 21.1. Alternative offers must be clearly marked as "Original Offer" and "Alternative Offer". Only the lower-priced bid will be considered if not properly marked.

The Bidder shall provide detailed supporting evidence for each clause under the Minimum Eligibility Criteria and Evaluation Criteria

### **Minimum Eligibility Criteria:**

- The bidder must be a legally registered entity in an eligible country.
- If not the manufacturer, the bidder must be formally authorized by the manufacturer to supply the goods.
- The bovine semen must originate from a country approved by the Department of Animal Production and Health (DAPH), Sri Lanka, and meet the following veterinary health requirements:
  - Bulls must be certified free from Brucellosis, Tuberculosis, Johne's Disease, Bovine Leukocyte Adhesion Disease (BLAD), Deficiency of Uridine Mono-Phosphate Synthetase (DUMPS), Citrullinemia, and Factor XI Deficiency.
  - Semen must comply with OIE Terrestrial Manual standards for international trade.
  - Certificates must be issued by a competent veterinary authority in the country of origin.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

Bids will be evaluated based on:

- **Price (50%):** Lowest CIP Colombo price.
- **Past Performance (20%):** Evidence of successful prior deliveries.
- **Quality of Documentation (20%):** Completeness and compliance of submitted documents (e.g., Veterinary Health Certificates, Certificate of Analysis).
- **Delivery Schedule (10%):** Feasibility and timeliness of proposed delivery.

1. Should be healthy and no sign of any disease on the day of collection.
2. Should be born and have been residing immediately prior to the date of the semen collection in the exporting country
3. The breeds of the donor animal should be in compliance with Sri Lanka National Breeding Policy or approved by breeding committee in Sri Lanka.
4. The parents should not be related.
5. The semen be been collected from progeny tested and proven sire.
6. Requirements for approval of Artificial insemination Centers should be in accordance with the chapter 4.6 of International animal Health Code 2023.
7. The semen should be collected, handled, processed and stored strictly under the conditions stated in the international animal health code, OIE 2023 article 4.7.5, 4.7.6 and 4.7.7.
8. Parenteral line should be free from genetic defects and disorders.
9. The donor animals should have never been used for natural service.
10. The Artificial Insemination Centre has to be licensed by the Government Veterinary Authority of the exporting country and should be under the supervision of a Government veterinary Authority.
11. Detail description of health management protocol adopted at the Artificial Insemination Centre certified by the Government Veterinary Authority to be furnished together with the specimen Veterinary Health Certificate.
12. The certificate of the country of origin should be certified by the relevant authority

*Health protocol may vary from time to time according to the disease status reported to WOAHA and the health status of the exporting country*
