Section I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB)

ITB shall be read in conjunction with Section II, Bidding Data Sheet (BDS), which shall take precedence over ITB.

01. INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND RATIONALE

01.1 The National Livestock Development Board (NLDB), established in 1973, is Sri Lanka's largest government-owned organization in the livestock sector, managing 30 livestock farms for breeding purposes. The NLDB aims to enhance its goat breeding farms to supply high-quality breeding stock, improve Boer goat germplasm in Sri Lanka, and meet the growing demand for goat meat breeds among local farmers. With increasing demand for quality meat and limited availability of high-yielding breeds, Boer goats, known for their rapid growth, superior meat quality, and adaptability, offer significant potential for breeders and meat producers. Supported by the Sri Lankan Government, the NLDB plans to establish a Boer goat breeding farm in the upcountry intermediate zone to promote high-quality meat goat production, address rising demand, enhance rural livelihoods, and contribute to national food security and livestock development.

01.2 Objective of the Project.

1. Establish a pure-breed Boer goat breeding unit under the NLDB.
2. Enhance Boer goat germplasm in Sri Lanka to improve meat production and genetic quality
3. Supply high-quality, healthy, pure breed Boer goats to meet the demands of the local farming community

will be conducted through Limited International Competitive Bidding (LIB) in strict compliance with the terms, conditions, and specifications outlined in the attached bidding documents.

- 01.4 Foreign suppliers or their accredited international agents/representatives for the Sri Lankan market are eligible to submit bids. If the bidder is participating as an agent, Valid documentary evidence must be provided to demonstrate their authority to act on behalf of the supplier
- 01.5 All animals must be registered with the regulatory authorities of the country of origin and subjected to thorough inspection and quarantine procedures as required, under the animal health authority of the country .
- 01.6 All bidders must submit the relevant documentation, including registration certificates, as requested by the buyer.

02 SUBMISSION OF BID

02.1. Bids must be submitted in **one original** and **one duplicate**, each sealed separately and clearly marked as “Original” and “Duplicate,” respectively. Both envelopes should then be enclosed in a single outer envelope, sealed and marked “**Bid for Importation of Breeder Boer Goats**”, and addressed to:

02.2. Sealed bids may be either sent by **registered post** to the above address or **hand-delivered** to the Tender Box placed at the same location. Bids must be received **on or before the closing date and time** specified.

02.3. Bids submitted via **fax or email** directly to NLDB **will not be accepted**.

02.4. The **top-left corner** of the outer envelope must clearly indicate the **Bid Reference Number**, as well as the **closing date and time** of submission.

02.5. All bids must be received by the **closing date and time specified in Section II.D. Late bids** will not be accepted and will be returned **unopened**.

02.6. The bidder must submit a **separate technical proposal, including a breeder certificate, pedigree, animal specification.... Etc,** and a **financial proposal**. Including price, discounts, payment terms, and options. etc

02.7. The bidder must **certify the authenticity** of all documents submitted with the bid through a sworn **affidavit**. This affidavit should include a **complete list** of all documents attached to the bid.

02.8. Bids must be submitted using the **prescribed format** provided in the NLDB Bidding Document (**Section iv , Annex A, B,C,D**).

02.9. All animals offered must **strictly comply** with the specifications outlined in **Section VI**

02.10. The selected supplier must arrange a **pre-inspection visit** for **three NLDB officials at the bidder's expense for a minimum of three days to examine the animals, check the records, and for final selection. Traveling, food, and lodging, inclusive, indicate the expenses in the price schedule separately.**

02.11. Bids that **do not conform** to, or are **non-responsive** to, the terms and conditions outlined herein **will be rejected**.

3. FORMAT OF BID

03.1. Bids should be submitted according to the formats given in **Section IV : Bidding farm**

03.2. However, only the item numbers will be announced at the bid opening. Therefore, the price must be clearly indicated against each corresponding item number.

03.2. Bids that are not submitted in the prescribed format or that fail to comply strictly with the terms, conditions, specifications, and veterinary health requirements outlined in this Bid will be rejected.

03.3. The bid must not contain any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting, except where necessary to correct an error. In such cases, the correction must be initialed by the person(s) signing the bid.

03.4. All bid documents, including supporting literature and correspondence, must be submitted in **English**.

03.5. The Corporation reserves the right to reject any bid that does not conform to the required specifications or is deemed non-responsive in any respect, at any stage, if such non-conformity or non-responsiveness is identified.

03.6. The bid must be **duly signed** and endorsed by the bidder, an authorized signatory (clearly indicating the name and designation), or a duly appointed representative. If a representative is submitting the bid on behalf of a company, a **letter of authorization** must be provided.

4. VALIDITY OF OFFER

04.1. Validity Period of the Bid - 119 **days** (One hundred Nineteen days)

5. BID OPENING

05.1. Bids will be opened immediately after the closing time at the **Head Office of the National Livestock Development Board**, located at **No. 40, Nawala Road, Narahenpita, Colombo 05, Sri Lanka**, on the **date and time specified in Section II D**.

05.2. Bidders or their duly authorized representatives are permitted to be present during the bid opening.

05.3. Only the envelope marked **“Original”** will be opened at the time of the bid opening.

05.4. The **Bid Opening Committee** will announce the **name of each bidder**, the **quoted amount**, and any **discounts offered**, to those present.

05.5. Any additional details deemed necessary by the Bid Opening Committee will also be read out.

6. FORCE MAJEURE

07.1. If the supplier is unable to fulfill the contract within the stipulated timeframe due to unavoidable circumstances classified as **Force Majeure**—such as war, natural disasters, epidemics, or freight disruptions—the delay may be excused. In such cases, the **Chairman of the Procurement Committee (NLDB)** reserves the right to either **grant an extension of the delivery period** or **terminate the award**, depending on the nature and severity of the situation.

7. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT

08.1. The contract shall not be assigned or sublet, in whole or in part, without prior written authorization. The **National Livestock Development Board (NLDB)** reserves the right to **refuse recognition of any Power of Attorney** issued by the contractor to a third party authorizing them to execute the contract on the contractor's behalf.

8. FREE REPLACEMENT / REIMBURSEMENT

09.1. The **National Livestock Development Board (NLDB)** reserves the right to request **free-of-cost replacements** for any goat that **dies during transit**, arrives in an **unfit condition** (including but not limited to being sick, injured, underweight, or deformed), or **fails the post-arrival health inspection** conducted by a **DAPH-approved veterinarian** within **seven (07) days** of arrival.

09.2. If a replacement is not feasible, the supplier shall **reimburse 125% of the C&F Colombo value** of the affected goat(s), inclusive of all **shipping and handling charges**. The **additional 25%** shall be treated as an **administrative penalty** for failure to meet the required quality standards.

10. DELIVERY

10.1. Shipping -Option I – Sea freight – Colombo port

Option II – Air freight – Bandaranaike International Airport

11. CRATING & TRANSPORT STANDARDS AND SUPPLIER PRE-QUALIFICATIONS

11.1. Pre-Shipment Holding Condition

- All **goats intended for delivery must be isolated** from the source Herd/ Farms and other animal species for a **minimum of 21 days** before shipment. This quarantine must take place in a **pre-selection quarantine facility (holding facility)**. The **supplier shall be fully responsible** for the care, feeding, and welfare of the animals during this period.
- The **supplier must submit a comprehensive quarantine plan**, detailing the procedures and facilities involved. This plan will be used to assess the supplier's **technical capacity** to manage the quarantine process for the proposed number of animals and the corresponding **delivery schedule**.
- Goats must be kept in **clean, well-ventilated housing** with adequate space, continuous access to **clean water**, and **veterinary care** throughout the quarantine period.
- The quarantine process must be conducted in accordance with **guidelines approved by the Department of Animal Production and Health (DAPH)**. Sri Lanka.

11.2. Quarantine Conditions

- During the quarantine period, the **supplier must appoint a dedicated quarantine management officer**, preferably a **qualified and experienced veterinarian**, to oversee all mandatory procedures, including **deworming** and **vaccination** with recommended vaccines.
- The quarantine officer must be responsible for **identifying any sick animals** and ensuring their **immediate isolation and removal** from the flock to prevent disease spread during the quarantine period.
- If, at the end of the quarantine period, the number of goats **positively**

selected is less than the quantity required under the supply agreement, the **supplier shall be responsible for re-supplying** the remaining number of goats. These additional animals must also undergo the **same quarantine period** at the **supplier's own expense**.

- The supplier must ensure an **adequate number of animals** are made available to enable **timely and proper selection** by the selection committee.
- If goats are **rejected at the final delivery location** due to health issues resulting from **poor transportation conditions**, the supplier must **resupply the rejected animals**, which must also be subjected to the **full quarantine period** at the **supplier's cost**.

11.3. Transport Condition

The **supplier shall be responsible** for transporting the goats to the designated **quarantine facility/site**. Following the quarantine period, the **selected goats must be transported by the supplier** to the specified **final delivery point**. The supplier must also provide detailed information regarding the **transport and handling arrangements**, including the **number of goats in transit**.

The **National Livestock Development Board (NLDB)** and the **Ministry of Agriculture of Sri Lanka** shall **not be responsible** for any **logistical, operational, or security-related issues** arising during the transportation or delivery of goats to the final destination.

The NLDB/Ministry of Agriculture shall only be liable to **make payment for goats that are pre-selected and successfully delivered** to the designated **distribution location**. Only **healthy goats in good physical condition**, delivered to the final destination, will be accepted by the buyer.

All animals must be shipped in **IATA-compliant livestock transport crates or containers**, suitable for **air freight and live animal export**.

11.4. Creating Condition

Crates must:

- Allow sufficient space for standing and turning.

- Be made of non-toxic, durable materials with proper ventilation.
- Males and females should be in separate creators

Be individually labeled with:

- Animal ID (tag number)
- Breed and sex
- Country of origin
- Exporter's name
- "Live Animal – Handle with Care" label

11.5. Feed and Water During Transit

- Adequate feeding and watering arrangements must be ensured throughout the entire duration of the journey
- Pre-export fasting and hydration plan must be submitted with the bid.

11.6. Temperature Control and Stress Minimization

- Ambient temperature must be monitored throughout transport.
- Use of **bedding** (e.g., straw or soft matting) in crates is mandatory to reduce stress and injury.

11.7. Post-Arrival Condition

- The **supplier is fully responsible** for ensuring that all animals arrive at the destination **healthy and free from injury**.
- Any case of **injury, mortality, or deterioration** resulting from **improper packing or handling** will invoke the **Free Replacement or Reimbursement Clause** as stipulated.

11.8. Responsibility

- The **supplier bears full responsibility** for ensuring that all **packing, handling, and transportation** are carried out in a **safe and compliant** manner.
- Any **costs, losses, or damages** arising from **non-compliance** shall be **entirely borne by the supplier**.
- A responsible officer should arrive/ be available from the supplier at the destination (BIA, Colombo) to hand over the animals and necessary items/ documents to the buyer

12. **BID PRICE & CURRENCY**

12.1. **Bid Price** - C & F (CPT/CFR) Colombo basis. **FOB offers are not acceptable.**

12.2. **Currency** - USD \$ /Euro

13. **COUNTRY OF ORIGIN, PORT OF SHIPMENT, AND SUPPLIER DETAILS**

13.1. The **quotation must include** the following details: **Country of Origin, Port of Shipment, HS Code** of the live goats, and **full details of the supplier.**

14. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS & CERTIFICATES**

14.1. Bidders must submit **all required animal health documents** and certifications as **Section III, Annex I**, as specified by the **Department of Animal Production and Health (Sri Lanka)**. These documents should include, but are not limited to: **Pedigree Certificates**, a detailed **Transit Plan** outlining **feeding and watering arrangements**, and any other relevant health-related documentation.

15. **PAYMENT & BANK CHARGES**

- 15.1. Payment shall be made as follows: **30% advance** upon signing of the contract, and the remaining **70% upon successful delivery and acceptance** of the animals, following **inspection and clearance by the Department of Animal Production and Health (DAPH)**. All payments will be made via an **Irrevocable Letter of Credit (L/C)**.
- 15.2. Suppliers must provide **complete beneficiary bank details** in their **original bid submission**. No changes to the beneficiary details will be accepted after the bid closing. If any changes result in the **cancellation or amendment** of an established L/C, the supplier shall bear **all associated costs**, including a **service charge**.
- 15.3. **All bank charges incurred outside Sri Lanka** shall be the **responsibility of the beneficiary**. Deliveries must be made **within the validity period of the L/C**. Extensions will be granted only under **exceptional circumstances**, and **any costs arising from such extensions will be borne by the supplier**.
- 15.4. The Letter of Credit will be advised through the **correspondent bank** of the NLDB's banker in the **supplier's country**. If the bidder wishes to use a **specific negotiating bank**, those details must be clearly stated in the bid.

16. CONTRACT

- 16.1. The **successful supplier** shall be required to **enter into a formal Contract/Agreement** (as per **Annex VI**) with the Corporation **within seven (07) days** of receiving the **Letter of Award**.

17. LOCAL AGENT

- 17.1. If there is a local agent for the supplier in Sri Lanka, the **supplier shall specify** in the bid the **name, address, and full contact details** of their **authorized agent in Sri Lanka**.

18. EXAMINATION, EVALUATION, AND COMPARISON OF OFFERS

18.1. The purpose of the bid evaluation is to identify the **lowest evaluated bid** among the **substantially responsive bids** received.

i) **Preliminary examination**

The **bids received** will be examined by the **Bid Evaluation Committee**, appointed for each procurement, to determine whether they are **complete**, submitted by **eligible bidders**, and whether the **required bid bond** has been furnished in the correct format. The Committee will also verify whether the bid has been **properly signed**, whether there is **only one offer**, check for any **computational errors**, confirm whether **samples have been provided** (if required), and ensure that the **specimen Bid Form** and **Price Schedule** have been correctly followed. As given in the (**Section IV**)

ii) **Prior to detailed evaluation criteria.**

- The **Bid Evaluation Committee** will assess the **substantial responsiveness** of each bid to ensure it fully complies with all the conditions outlined in the bidding documents, without any **deviations or omissions**.
- The **National Livestock Development Board (NLDB)** will further examine all bids to verify their **accuracy and consistency**. Any **arithmetical errors** identified during the evaluation will be corrected based on the following principles:
 - a) If there is a **discrepancy between the unit price and the total price**, the **unit price shall prevail**, and the total price will be adjusted accordingly.
 - b) If there is a **discrepancy between figures and words**, the **amount**

stated in words shall prevail.

c) If there is a **discrepancy between the original and the duplicate copy** of the bid, the **original version shall prevail.**

- **All goats offered must strictly conform to the technical specifications** outlined in the bidding documents.

- iii) The **NLDB will identify and list bids that conform to the required technical specifications** as the **most substantially responsive bids**, regardless of whether they are the lowest, second lowest, third lowest, etc., in terms of price.
- iv) Evaluation will be conducted in accordance with the criteria specified in the **Standard Bidding Document (SBD).**
- v) **Preliminary Evaluation:**
 - Completeness of the bid
 - Submission of bid security
 - Proper signatures and authorizations
- vi) **Technical Evaluation:**
 - Compliance with technical specifications
 - Supplier's capacity and resources
 - Past performance
 - Relevant experience and proven track record
- vii) **Financial Evaluation:**
 - Delivery timeline
 - Price competitiveness and overall cost-effectiveness
- viii) **Quality Assurance Evaluation:**
 - Measures proposed by the supplier to ensure animal health, handling standards, and adherence to quality protocols

19. BID AWARD

- 19.1. The Corporation will **notify the successful bidder via email**, followed by an official **Letter of Award**, confirming that the bid has been accepted.

- 19.2. Awards will be granted to suppliers based on a comprehensive evaluation, taking into account various factors such as the **prices quoted, past performance, quality of samples, proposed delivery timeline, product registration**, and other relevant criteria.
- 19.3. **NLDB Procurement Committee reserves the right**, without obligation to provide justification, to:
- a) **Accept any bid** in whole or in part;
 - b) **Accept portions** from more than one bid;
 - c) **Reject any or all bids** submitted;
 - d) **Instruct that fresh bids be invited**;
 - e) **Cancel the bidding process** at its discretion.
- 19.4. If an award is granted under this bid, the **NLDB reserves the right to cancel or suspend the procurement** at any stage if the supplier is **listed as a defaulted supplier** due to **quality failures in previous deliveries** to NLDB or for **non-compliance with any contractual obligations**.

20. COPY DOCUMENTS

- 20.1. The **successful bidder** shall agree to **send a complete set of shipping documents** to NLDB via **email or courier at least seven (07) days prior to the arrival** of the consignment in Sri Lanka, in order to **avoid any delays in customs clearance**.
- 20.2. **Failure to comply** with the requirement of submitting shipping documents at least **seven (07) days before the consignment's arrival** may result in **demurrage or additional charges**, which will be **claimed from the supplier**.

The complete set of documents to be dispatched via **email or courier** must include the following:

- i. **Copy of Bill of Lading (BL) or Air Waybill (AWB)**
- ii. **Veterinary Health Certificates, Export Permits, Insurance Certificates, Pedigree Certificates, Transit Plan** (including feeding and watering arrangements), **Certificate of Origin**, and any other required documentation.
- iii. **Packing List**, clearly stating:
 - Individual **gross and net weights** in kilograms
 - **Outer dimensions** of each crate
 - **Total number of crates**
 - **Transit temperature, feeding status**, presence of **escort veterinarian**, and **all other relevant transport details**
- iv. **Commercial Invoice**, indicating:
 - **Breakdown of CPT/CFR values** (showing **FOB and Freight** components)
 - **Applicable HS Code**
 - All other necessary shipment and payment information

20.3. For **air freight consignments**, all required documents **must be submitted via email**. This is a **mandatory requirement** that the **successful bidder must comply with** to ensure timely clearance of the cargo upon arrival and to **avoid demurrage charges**.

Any **demurrage or additional charges** incurred due to the supplier's **failure to meet this requirement** will be **recovered from the supplier**.

21. ALTERNATIVE BIDS

21.1. If the bidder submits **alternative offers**, each bid must be clearly marked as “**Original Offer**” and “**Alternative Offer**”. The accompanying **Bid Bond** must explicitly state that it **covers both the original and alternative offers**. Failure to comply with this requirement will result in **only the lower-priced bid** being considered for evaluation.

22. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Prospective bidders are expected to thoroughly familiarize themselves with all terms and conditions outlined in this document. If further clarification is required, they are advised to **contact the undersigned before bid submission**.

No claims of lack of awareness or insufficient information will be accepted at any stage of the procurement process.

The **National Livestock Development Board (NLDB)** reserves the right to **reject any offer that does not comply** with the above condition

Technical Specifications for Purebred Boer Goats

1. General Requirements

- **Species & Breed:** Capra hircus – Purebred Boer goats, officially registered with internationally recognized breed registries such as the American Boer Goat Association (ABGA) or the South African Boer Goat Breeders' Association (SABGBA).
- **Age at Delivery:** Between 12 and 18 months.
- **Weight & Height:**
 - **Does:** 35–45 kg; 65–80 cm at the withers
 - **Bucks:** 45–55 kg; 75–90 cm at the withers
- **Frame Type:** Medium to large frame with a robust, muscular conformation indicative of a meat-type breed. Animals should not be undersized or oversized to maintain optimal productivity and breed standard.
- **Coat Color:**
 - White body with reddish brown head and neck, adhering to $\geq 75\%$ dark pigmentation on exposed areas such as ears and under the tail.
- **Adaptability:** Animals must demonstrate proven adaptability to Sri Lanka's upcountry intermediate zone, which features an elevation of ~1850 m, rainfall between 1750–2500 mm annually, and average ambient temperatures of 18–28 °C.
- **Body Condition Score (BCS):** BCS of 4 to 5 (on a 1–9 scale) indicating ideal health and reproductive readiness.

2. Confirmation Standards

- **Head:** Strong, broad skull with soft brown eyes, Roman nose profile, and well-formed nostrils. Acceptable bite allowance is ≤ 6 mm overshoot in animals over 24 months.
- **Horns:** Backward-sweeping, well-spaced, firm, and uniformly pigmented.
- **Ears:** Pendulous, medium length, smooth and wide, free of deformities or folds.

- **Neck & Shoulders:** Muscular neck of moderate length, well-integrated with sloping shoulders and deep brisket.
- **Forelimbs & Chest:** Broad chest with straight, well-aligned forelegs; strong pasterns and dark, correctly oriented hooves.
- **Barrel & Backline:** Broad and deep barrel with well-sprung ribs, muscular loins, and a level, firm topline.
- **Hindquarters:** Well-fleshed rump, powerful thighs, and straight tail set with unrestricted movement.
- **Skin & Coat:** Supple, elastic skin with a minimum of 75% pigmentation in exposed areas (100% ideal); coat should be short, glossy, and dense.

3. Udder and Reproductive Soundness

- **Does:**
 - **Udder:** Symmetrical, high, and wide with a strong medial suspensory ligament; fore and rear udders should blend smoothly with the body.
 - **Teats:** Preferably 1x1 (one functional teat per half); 1x2 or 2x2 acceptable. Teats must be cylindrical, medium-sized, evenly placed, and directed downward for ease of nursing.
 - **Reproductive Health:** Free from abnormalities such as udder swellings, edema, or mastitis. No supernumerary or malformed teats that interfere with function.
- **Bucks:**
 - Two uniformly sized testicles with a minimum scrotal circumference of 25 cm; scrotal split must not exceed 5 cm.
 - Prepuce and penis should be structurally normal and free from abnormalities.

- **Other:** Wry or twisted tail base, umbilical or abdominal hernias.




