REQUEST FOR QUOTATION /PROPOSAL

Hiring Veterinary Services for Reproductive Management in NLDB Farms

The National Livestock Development Board (NLDB), which maintains large-scale livestock breeding farms, plans to hire veterinary services for its farms mainly for reproductive management activities, especially in Cattle and buffalo farms, and for farm visits. The following are the main farms, locations, and a summary of their details

Main activities related to reproductive management to be carried out by the veterinarians are as follows.

1. Confirmation of pregnancy
 - a. By rectal examination of all served animals 45 days after breeding
 - b. By Ultrasound scanning 28 days after breeding
2. Synchronization of non-pregnant animals
 - a. Synchronization programs depending on the status of the ovaries
 - b. Bringing non-pregnant cyclic animals into estrus as early as possible
3. Determining ovarian activities and treating them to make them functional, or making recommendations accordingly
4. Achieving standard reproductive performances in cow and heifer herds
5. Examination of repeat breeders, animals with breeding problems and pathologies in the reproductive system, and treating them accordingly
6. Recording all findings in the computer system or manual system immediately after every examination program by the veterinarian.
7. Selection of animals for culling, considering reproductive status and economic aspects
8. Making a comprehensive report at the end of each farm visit based on findings and making recommendations to achieve herd performance targets

Other conditions

1. Only veterinarians registered under the Veterinary Council of Sri Lanka (VCSL) can apply. A single veterinarian of a group of veterinarians may apply, but details of all veterinarians involved should be provided with the bid.


2. An individual veterinarian or a company can apply. Only veterinarians are permitted to examine animals.
 3. Experience in farm animal practice will be highly considered. Working experience in NLDB large-scale farms will be an added advantage. Details about the experience should be provided in a letter along with the bid.
 4. A selection interview will be held, and the evidence on experience should be provided.
 5. The capacity of the veterinarian to provide the service to the selected farms or all farms to cover the weekly or monthly visits should be provided with a plan on how to implement the visit plan in a supportive letter, along with the bid. (Format attached)
 6. Transport and other logistics should be borne by the veterinarian/bidder.
 7. Biosecurity measures should be strictly followed by the veterinarian. Overalls, gumboots. Gloves, etc used for other farms should not be brought in. A separate set of clothing will be arranged on the farm. No other visitors, helpers, or persons are allowed to be brought into the farm other than a driver if necessary.
 8. No photos or videos are allowed to be taken inside the farm. They cannot be published anywhere, including social media. No details about the farms, their operations, animals, etc, should be shared with any other third parties. Such behaviors will be seriously considered, and actions will be taken accordingly.
 9. The findings of the examination and animal or farm data should not be used for any other purposes, such as research publications, media, training, etc. They are confidential data and should be kept confidential.
 10. Should be able to coordinate with the manager and arrange dates and times convenient to both parties. Monthly or weekly programs should not be delayed unnecessarily. Working on routine and attending programs on time will be evaluated.
 11. Should be available to explain the situation, progress, and plans to the top management if and when necessary, participating in the progress review meetings.
 12. Once selected and service is offered, an agreement will be made between the two parties.
 13. Only the selected veterinarian/s is allowed to carry out the service, and he or she is not allowed to nominate others to replace him/her unless they are in the original bid.
 14. Service quality will be evaluated, and low performance or unsatisfactory service quality will lead to the termination of the service.
 15. Farms will use their own drugs and hormones for synchronizations or treatments, and the veterinarian may recommend the necessary drugs to be arranged in advance of his/her visit. No outside drugs are permitted to be used, or claims for such bills will not be paid.
01. Price schedule Format (Annexure 01) is attached here with and the bidder may use the same format for bidding or may prepare their own schedule similar to the given format.

The quotation should be sent through registered post to reach the **Chairman – Procurement Committee, National Livestock Development Board (NLDB), P.O.Box 1748, No.40, Nawala Road, Narahenpita, Colombo 05**, or deposited in the quotation box available in this office not later than **10.30 am on 31 / 07 / 2025** The opening will be held at NLDB Head office on **31 / 07 / 2025** at the same venue.

Please indicate the quotation number/name and the closing date on the top left-hand corner of the envelope.

Terms & Conditions

01. The bidder or his/her authorized persons should duly sign in each specified document (Specification & price schedule) and the official stamp should be placed. The date should be mentioned in the quotation.
02. Alterations in the bid documents are not accepted unless they are duly signed by the bidder. Whiting or erasing figures or words in the bid is not accepted, and such alterations may lead to reject the bid.
03. **Validity** - This quotation should be valid for the entire period of the Contract.
04. **Mode of payment** - payment will be made by cheque by the Assistant. General Manager (Finance) of NLDB every month.
05. Invoice, along with the monthly "work done" report, should be submitted to each respective farm at the end of each month
